Scriptures:

Mat 16:24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, 'If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross, and follow me.' TPT

Phil 1:27 'but whatever happens to me, you must live in a manner worthy of the Good News about Christ, as citizens of Heaven. Then whether I come and see you again or only hear about you, I will know that you are standing side by side, fighting together for the Good News.'

Phil 3:20 But we are citizens of Heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives.'

Mark 16:15 'Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone, everywhere. Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved.'

Discussion Questions:

1. How does the above scripture relate to your life right now?
2. Do you have a testimony of how your life changed after making Jesus Lord of your life?
3. Someone said 'Discipleship is not the communication of ideas, but a communication of life'. Do you have an example of when discipleship brought life into your walk with God, or brought life to someone you were ministering to?
4. Discuss the following scripture and how it relates to Jesus' Lordship in our lives. How do these scriptures relate to what is happening in our world today?

Act 4:24 When they heard the report, all the believers lifted their voices together in prayer to God: "O Sovereign Lord, Creator of heaven and earth, the sea, and everything in them—

Act 4:29 And now, O Lord, hear their threats, and give us, Your servants, great boldness in preaching Your word.

Act 4:30 Stretch out Your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of Your holy servant Jesus."

Act 4:31 After this prayer, the meeting place shook, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. Then they preached the word of God with boldness.
